

If hemp replaced cotton globally, the increased fiber yield would free up an area of farmland about the size of the state of Florida. The reduction in highly toxic pesticides would match the weight of a fully loaded aircraft carrier – the USS Enterprise – or 94,080 tons, to be precise.

In the USA, approximately 1.4 billion cotton T shirts are sold each year. If these were replaced by Hemptown T shirts: The energy savings (3.486 million GJ) would provide household power for a full year to 92,361 people – about the population of Santa Barbara, CA or Miami Beach, FL.

The water savings (1,339 billion gallons) would satisfy the household water consumption for more than half the population of the USA for a full year!

Think about it.
